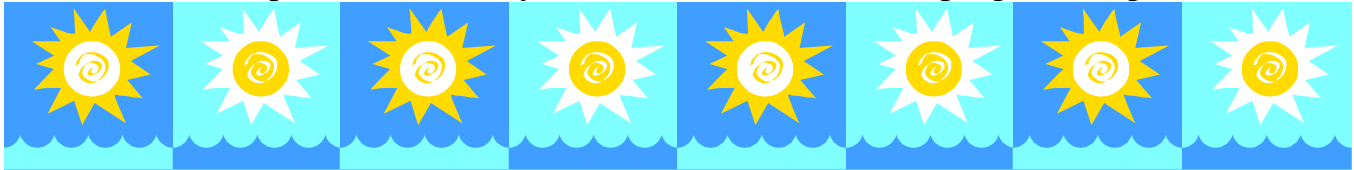

Melrose Public Schools is pleased to announce the third season of *Campus KIDS*, our own summer enrichment programming. Students will travel through weekly themes to experience festive sights, sounds and tastes from around the world. Campus KIDS - **K**inesthetic and **I**nteresting **D**ays of **S**ummer - is designed to make the most of physical activity, curiosity and warm weather. Plenty of opportunities for kinesthetic physical activity are given through swimming, organized sports, cooperative gym games, water play, music/movement sessions and outdoor free play. A variety of activities keep each day interesting as students participate in arts/crafts, library/literacy, field trips, cooking, exchange learning, computer/technology and team building challenges. The days of summer will be packed with smiles and great memories. Expect friends, creative projects, swimming, ice cream, water balloons and good times!

Dr. Josephson and her talented team are guiding students on another Campus KIDS global tour this summer! Our diverse curriculum and rotating stations have been very successful in keeping student interest levels high while engaging them in a variety of fun activities. To complement this structure, students will now have more choices in how to spend their time during our new afternoon electives. Every Tuesday and Thursday afternoon, students will intensively explore the activity of their choice. One of the electives offered this summer is Nature KIDS. Every Tuesday and Thursday afternoon, the students in that elective are transported to local outdoor favorites like Breakheart Reservation and Middlesex Fells Reservation to walk the trails. Students currently enrolled in kindergarten through fourth grade are eligible to join in the summer adventures! Preschool programming is also available for three, four and five-year-old children *who have attended pre-K during the previous year*. Students are grouped by age/grade level to enjoy summer activities led by our skilled and caring staff. We welcome back our fabulous Campus KIDS team of certified teachers, college students, and high school student mentors. This year, screened, trained, and supervised volunteers will be included in programming. Volunteerism will allow members of the community to contribute to the summer experience. Registered nurses are also supporting the program. While the majority of our familiar team members are returning, we will welcome some new staff this year.

Campus KIDS takes place at the Roosevelt School, where kids may enjoy the open green space, play structures and air-conditioned indoor amenities (i.e. gym, cafe and computer lab). Activities take place both on and off campus. At the Roosevelt, students participate in summer fun while experiencing life in different countries around the globe. Each Wednesday afternoon, students go on a field trip to an exciting venue. Swimming trips are provided (about twice per week) at no extra charge. **Preschool students DO NOT leave campus.** Their enrichment activities are provided on site.

Parents may customize a schedule that works best for their family. Campus KIDS offers many flexible attendance options. Summer sessions run in weekly blocks. Parents may choose to have their child attend only certain weeks, or the entire eight weeks. Parents may elect to send their student to Campus KIDS on particular days of each week, or every day Monday through Friday. Half day (mornings or afternoons), full day and extended day options are available each week. Campus KIDS will begin on Monday, June 25th, and conclude on Friday, August 17th, 2012. Please note the program will be closed for the holiday on Wed, July 4th and tuition is reduced for that week of only four days.

Registration will open February 27th, 2012. A registration fee of \$25 per student is required for the 2012 summer season. Campus KIDS offers significantly discounted rates for sibling tuitions. An early registration and payment discount applies to registrations **received and paid in full** by June 4th, 2012. Registrations and schedule changes received after June 4th, 2012 will be accommodated on a first-come, first-served basis, as space allows. **Students will receive placement if their registration and tuition payments are received by June 4th, 2012.** After that time, students with unpaid balances/incomplete paperwork are not assured placement. Thanks for your understanding, as many different families need to be accommodated. Payment plans may be arranged by emailing amiliotis@melrose.mec.edu.

Registration is to be completed by following the links online at www.MelroseSchools.com (click on the left side link to Education Stations). **Registration confirmation and invoices will be sent via email**, so please be sure to accurately enter your most frequently checked email address. Enrollment will fill up quickly, so register early to ensure your preferred schedule.
