

4th grade Supply List 2010-2011

Folders and paper

5 pocket folders (no prongs) one each of green, blue, purple, red, and yellow

5 more 2-pocket folders of any color (no prongs)

Target sells these in August for 5-10¢ each.

5 or more spiral bound notebooks, wide ruled paper, one subject

We use many spirals in Mathematics – Target sells packages of these in August 10 notebooks/\$1.00 and you may need all ten.

If your child is left-handed, bound composition books are a better choice so that the arm doesn't rest on the spiral during writing.

1 pkg. 3x5" index cards, lined, white

2 pkgs. 3"x3" post-it notes (usual style, not "accordion" style for desktop holders)

Any extra notebooks and folders can be stored, labeled with your child's name, in the classroom for future use.

Writing Instruments

#2 pencils, the standard yellow, nothing fancy

and/or a few mechanical pencils, 9mm lead which is the equivalent of a #2 pencil

These come with extra lead inside each pencil. There is no need to buy a container of extra lead or any extra erasers.

Two highlighters, different colors

Two red pens for correcting

One box of colored pencils, Crayola Twistables if possible, but standard pencils are fine

Other

One large eraser, nothing fancy

One good quality plastic ruler with inches and centimeters (not the flexible rubber kind)

One large glue stick

One pair of child's scissors, good quality, labeled with your child's name

One pencil case that **zips** closed

Art

One sketchbook, spiral bound

An old t-shirt, if you wish

No erasable pens , markers, staplers, calculators, protractors or compasses, please
