

Union Negotiations:

At any given time, the School Committee might be conducting negotiations with some of our union memberships. The negotiating teams usually consist of at least the Superintendent and the School Committee legal council. At times, there may be other members such as the Business Manager, School Committee members, and the Mayor.

The union negotiations are conducted in closed meetings. Occasionally, the negotiating team will report to the School Committee during Executive Session to discuss possible future bargaining positions. When the negotiations are complete, the School Committee will ratify the contract during an Executive Session, and the Union will ratify the same contract during one of their meetings. After this is complete on both sides, the new contract becomes public
