Any student reaching the age of 18 may apply for age majority status. Age majority, in effect, allows the student to be recognized by the school as an adult so that they may be accorded the privileges of an adult, signing of attendance records to include dismissal notes, requesting records, and/or other similar type activities. Majority status is privilege, not a right.

Legal Status: Students reaching the age of 18 are afforded the right to vote by Federal Statute.
