In order for students to ask questions and get an understanding about the grade level that they will be entering next year, we have scheduled a step-up day on June 11th for grades K-4. Class List Reminders

Please be reminded that we will be informing students of their teacher for the '09-'10 school year in August. The creation of class lists will be a process in which a team of school personnel (teachers, special education teacher, psychologist, principal, etc.) will come together to discuss every child and we will compose the lists based on *some* of the following criteria:

- 1) Pairing student personalities & learning styles with particular teachers personalities & teaching styles (although an older child had a particular teacher in the past, it does not necessarily mean that the younger child is the best match for that same teacher)
- 2) Balance of strengths and weaknesses of the students
- 3) The needs of students (special education, gifted and talented, etc.)
- 4) Male : female ratio
