Getting off task	Serious lack of respect for others including ridicule or exclusion	Uncooperative during in-school suspension	Theft
Speaking out of turn, too loudly, or when not allowed	False accusation	Use of physical force including slapping, punching, kicking, intentionally tripping, biting, or fighting	Assault on school personnel
Using property without permission (didn't ask)	Failure to follow adult's direction	Intimidation, harassment, endangerment or threatening others	Weapon in school or on school grounds
Distracting others with objects or behavior	Swearing or vulgar language or gesture	Throwing potentially harmful objects in school or on the playground including but not limited to pebbles, rocks, mulch and/or snowballs	Use or possession of threatening, highly disruptive or potentially harmful devices in school or on school grounds
Running in the building	Dishonesty or cheating	Continued Bullying	Illegal substance in school
Cutting in line or giving "cuts"	Failure to own up to misbehavior	Inappropriate explicit talk, act, or sharing materials	Alcohol and/or tobacco products in school or on school grounds
Littering or not cleaning up after oneself	Taking someone's property	Violation of another student's civil rights	Under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs in school or at school function

1 <sup>st</sup> Time: Warning, Discussion, restitution as appropriate, possible parent talk, possible removal from activity, possible missing of privilege	1 <sup>st</sup> Time: Discussion, restitution as appropriate, apology, Responsibility Think Sheet filled out and parent signature obtained, removal from activity, missing of privilege, missing of recess.	1 <sup>st</sup> Time: Discussion, restitution as appropriate, apology, Responsibility Think Sheet filled out, parent meeting, removal from activity, missing of privilege, missing of recess. 1 session of detention and possibility of 1 hour to 3 day in school or home suspension	Any Student charged with an emergency misbehavior will be notified of an opportunity for hearing.  Any Student committing an emergency misbehavior is subject to expulsion.  See Emergency Misbehavior Consequences under the Education reform Act of 1993.

3 <sup>rd</sup> Time: Discussion, restitution as appropriate, Responsibility Think Sheet filled out and parent signature obtained, removal from activity, loss of privilege & recess.	3 <sup>rd</sup> Time: Discussion, restitution, apology, Responsibility Think Sheet filled out, parent meeting, removal from activity, loss of privilege & recess. 2 sessions of detention.	3 <sup>rd</sup> Time: Discussion, restitution, apology, Responsibility Think Sheet, parent meeting, removal from activity, loss of privilege & recess. 4 sessions of detention and up to 10 days in school or home suspension.	
4 <sup>th</sup> Time+: Discussion, restitution as appropriate, apology, Responsibility Think Sheet filled out and parent signature obtained, removal from activity, loss of privilege & recess. 1 session of detention.	4 <sup>th</sup> Time+: Discussion, restitution, apology, Responsibility Think Sheet filled out, parent meeting, removal from activity, loss of privilege & recess. 3 sessions of detention. Possible in or home suspension	4 <sup>th</sup> Time+: Discussion, restitution, apology, Responsibility Think Sheet, parent meeting, removal from activity, loss of privilege & recess.
